Jefferson County is searching for a permanent, full-time Registered Nurse to work as our Public Health Director. This position reports directly to the County Health Board and County Commissioners. This position is instrumental in implementing and carrying out appropriate policies, procedures, programs and training to ensure the health and safety of employees, and county residents in accordance with all applicable public health legislation and regulations. This position performs health education, screenings, communicable disease surveillance and investigation, immunizations, promotion of individual and community health through a wide variety of prevention programs, and grant oversight. The Director is expected to exercise independent professional judgment based on department needs and project assignments. Management, computer and budgeting skills a must with experience assessing, evaluating and responding appropriately to health and workflow needs. Knowledge of state and federal regulations as related to public health a must. Applicants must have a current Montana RN license, CPR certificate and valid MT driver's license. Position requires graduation from an accredited school of nursing with a BSN. Preference will be given to applicants with a higher degree in nursing and experience.
